

New FIEC President and Steering Committee elected for the mandate 2026-2028

Following the FIEC General Assembly meeting held in Paris on 29 May, Jean-Pierre PASERI is the new President of the European Construction Industry Federation, at the head of the newly elected Steering Committee.

Jean-Pierre Paseri succeeds Piero Petrucco, whose term of office has come to its statutory end. He is a civil engineer, who graduated in 1986 from the the *École Spéciale des Travaux Publics* (ESTP). President of *Routes de France* and Vice-President of FIEC's French member, *Fédération Nationale des Travaux Publics* (FNTP), he has devoted his entire career to the construction of transport infrastructures and in particular roads and freeways. In all his missions within *Eurovia* (now *Vinci Construction*), he oversaw the "railway" subsidiary, road construction activity including industries, demolition activity and road equipment, in France, throughout Europe and at international level. Very active in the field of infrastructures and reduction of greenhouse gas emissions, he is currently leading the drafting of the profession's "decarbonisation" roadmap for *Routes de France*. Since 2023, he represents the interests of the construction industry at European level as FIEC Vice-President in charge of Technical and Environmental Affairs and as FIEC First Vice-President (since May 2025).

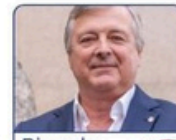
