Proposal for a Regulation amending the « driving times » (EC 561/2006) and the « tachograph » (EU 165/2014) Regulations

Proposed amendment

Regulation EC 561/2006 Article 3 paragraph (aa)

Existing text

This Regulation shall not apply to carriage by road by:

(aa) vehicles or combination of vehicles with a maximum permissible mass not exceeding 7,5 tonnes used for carrying materials, equipment or machinery for the driver's use in the course of his work, and which are used only within a 100 km radius from the base of the undertaking and on the condition that driving the vehicle does not constitute the driver's main activity:

Amendment

This Regulation shall not apply to carriage by road by:

(aa) vehicles or combination of vehicles used for carrying materials, equipment or machinery for the driver's **company** use in the course of his work, and which are used only within a **150** km radius from the base of the undertaking and on the condition that driving the vehicle does not constitute the driver's main activity;

Justification:

This proposal is in line with the objective of simplification and reduction of administrative and financial burden for construction enterprises, and namely construction SMEs¹.

Indeed, in some areas – typicallly rural areas – construction enterprises can have to go beyond the current 100 km maximum derogation radius to supply a construction site with materials, equipment and machinery. But they never drive long distance either.

Moreover, the conditions for obtaining the driving license for heavy goods vehicles, as well as the initial and lifelong training of the drivers ensure the respect of security conditions.

Finally, this activity of driving heavy goods vehicles occurs only for the driver's company use, whose main activity is construction. Hence, it does not concern the transportation of goods for a third-party. Consequently, the derogation does not distort competition within the Internal Market.
